1. IF YOU PLAN TO TRAVEL FROM AN AREA WITH A HIGH NUMBER OF CONFIRMED COVID-19 CASES OR HAVE RECENTLY VISITED SUCH AN AREA, PLEASE REMAIN AT HOME AND BID ONLINE OR ALLOW US TO HANDLE YOUR BIDS!
2. ONLINE BIDDING: The entire sale will be broadcast live by LiveAuctionsTV at www.liveauctions.tv displaying all cattle by video. PLEASE SIGN UP EARLY TO INSURE YOUR BIDDER APPROVAL.
3. IF YOU HAVE A COUGH OR FEVER OR ARE CONSIDERED HIGH RISK BECAUSE OF A PRE-EXISTING CONDITION: PLEASE DO NOT ENTER THE FACILITY.
4. WE WILL BE HONORED TO HANDLE YOUR BIDS! OUR DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVES WILL GLADLY REPRESENT YOUR INTEREST CONFIDENTIALLY. A LIST OF SALE CONTACTS IS PROVIDED BELOW. PLEASE LET US KNOW HOW WE CAN BE OF ASSISTANCE!
5. HEALTH PROFESSIONALS HAVE ADVISED US THAT, FOR YOUR SAFETY, WE WILL NOT PROVIDE FOOD SERVICE DUE TO COVID-19. BOTTLED WATER AND CANNED SODA WILL BE AVAILABLE.
6. SETTLEMENT IS OPTIONAL. IF YOU DO NOT SETTLE FOR YOUR PURCHASES SALE DAY, YOU WILL BE INVOICED IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE SALE.
7. LOAD OUT: We will accommodate anyone wanting to load out sale day. Please do make settlement and pick up your health papers and load out sheet before proceeding to the load out. Please be patient with our clerical staff as we will have limited access points.
8. WASH YOUR HANDS: Our restrooms are furnished with plenty of good old soap and water! Hand sanitizers and paper towels are located throughout the facility for your use. Please be sure to wash your hands or use sanitizer frequently.
9. MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCE: The CDC recommends maintaining a social distance of 6 feet. It's difficult since we are friends, business partners and family. To assist in social distancing, we ask that only registered bidders and sale staff be in the sale barn facility. Let's work hard to do it and stay well!
10. TAKE IT TO THE TRASH! Please be personally responsible for disposing of all items you touch (i.e.: tissues, paper towels, beverage cans and bottles).
